Continuous evaluation and self-appraisal are the means, by which one can try to give his / her best. As said by the world renowned teacher Aristotle 'Quality is not an act. It is a habit'.

People who have chosen careers as teachers in higher education owe it to themselves, to their students, and to their institutions to fulfill their responsibilities as effectively as

possible. The only way to evolve as a better teacher is to continuously monitor and evaluate teaching, and then to use the information obtained to make needed changes. Evaluation of teaching and correcting oneself in the right direction helps the teachers to evolve into better teachers.

Each year faculty members in institutions of higher education take on the task of teaching others. For most of these people, this is a recurring task. In fact, for the majority, this is the central task of a life-long career. Assuming that no one is perfect and therefore everyone has room for improvement, evaluation is the means by which we try to identify which aspects of our teaching are good and which need to be changed. The question then arises as to who should take responsibility for doing this evaluation. We at Nizam College believe that evaluation is an inherent part of good teaching. Therefore it is the teacher himself or herself who should take primary responsibility for doing the evaluation.

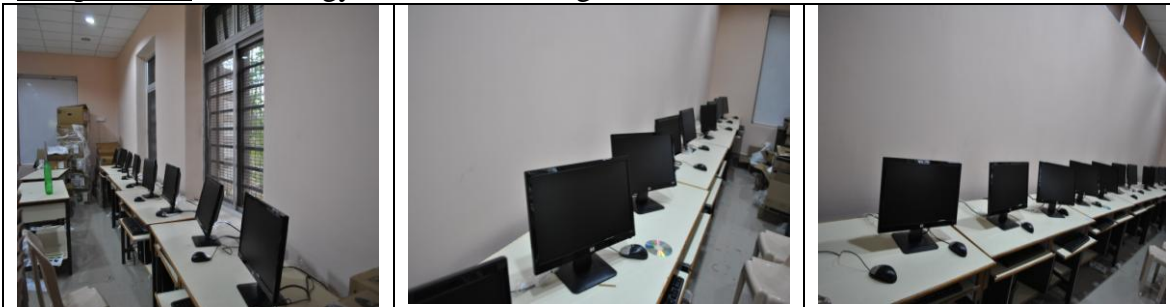

### Grants Received

UGC has sanctioned a sum of Rs. 10,43,904 under XI Plan for **College Development Program**.

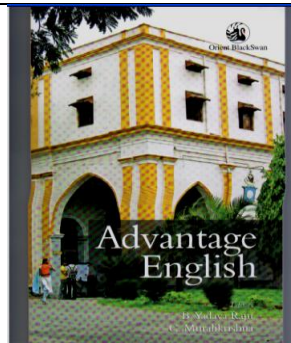
UGC has sanctioned to **Science P.G. Dept** a sum of Rs 5,25,000 for the establishment of “**Instruments Maintenance Facility**”.

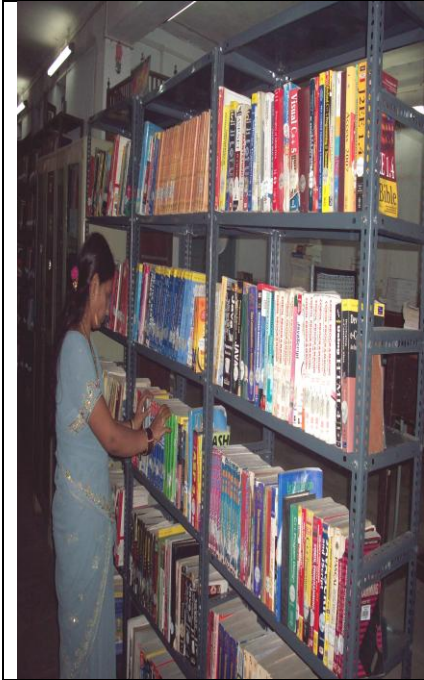
